Re: RoHS Statement of Conformity

Dear customer,

Thank you for the inquiry regarding the compliance of Poly products to the European RoHS Directive 2011/65/EC, including Directive (EU) 2015/863. The RoHS Directive restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment, specifically; lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP).

Lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP, and DIBP are not used as formulation components when manufacturing this product except in applications covered by current RoHS exemptions.

Poly products have been verified as RoHS compliant through testing and supplier certifications. Any presence of the restricted substances would only be as a naturally occurring impurity and does not exceed the maximum concentrations of 0.1% for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP, and DIBP, nor 0.01% for cadmium except in applications covered by RoHS exemptions.
