How Data Subject Rights Are Supported

The following information shows how data subject rights are supported.

Right to Access

A data subject has the right to view and/or obtain a copy of all personal data for a specific data subject. Personal data about devices, admin or user accounts, or specific participants in conferences can be viewed using the system web interface.

A copy of any personal data made available to Poly when working with Poly support is available by requesting it from your Poly support representative.

How long is personal data kept?

Any personal data made available when working with Poly support, specific to a support incident, is retained until the information is requested to be removed by the customer.

Conference history is stored for 3 months. Older information is automatically cleaned.

Is personal data shared with any third parties, and if so, who?

If personal data is made available when working with Poly support, this data may be shared with Poly's engineering team (which may include third parties/contractors).

How can a data subject be notified of a data breach?

Data subjects have a right to be notified when their data has been processed without authorization. The Poly support team is able to monitor and identify when certain security anomalies have occurred.

Right to Data Portability

A data subject has the right to receive a copy of all personal data in a commonly used, machine-readable format.

The system log files can be exported in zip format.

Log files

System log files Logs can be viewed or downloaded. The view feature shows the last 500 lines from the administrator interface. The downloaded log files have the privacy information encrypted.

To view logs:

- 1 Log in to the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite with administrator privileges
<https://<workflowIPAddress>/admin>
- 2 Select *admin-logs*.
- 3 Select the **Download logs** button in right corner.
- 4 This sends the logs in a *ZIP* file and downloads it to your PC.
- 5 Open a support ticket with Poly to request the log to be decrypted.
- 6 Poly sends you the decrypted logs.

The system configurations can be exported in *.zip* format.

Configuration files

System log files You can view or download log. The view feature shows the last 500 lines from the administrator interface. The downloaded log files have the privacy information encrypted.

To view logs:

- 1 Log in to the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite with administrator privileges <https://<workflowIPAddress>/admin>
- 2 Select configuration download from the dashboard from page.
- 3 This downloads the configuration in a .zip file to your PC.

Right to Erasure

A data subject has the right to remove all personal data.

Any personal data made available when working with Poly support, specific to a support incident, is retained until the information is requested to be removed by the customer.

Right to Rectification

A data subject has the right to make corrections to inaccurate or incomplete personal data.

The Workflow Suite & Clariti Workflow Lite processes data from Microsoft Exchange and passes this to the video endpoint to display as a **Select to join** button. If the personal data needs rectification, it should be rectified on the system of origin for the data. In this case, Microsoft Exchange environment will pass the rectified data to the Clariti Workflow Lite.

Personal data about specific participants in conferences cannot be edited or updated because the information derives from the device of origin.

Poly doesn't manipulate data made available during the support process, so any rectification of inaccuracies of personal data must be performed by the customer directly.

How Administrators Are Informed of Any Security Anomalies (Including Data Breaches)

How Administrators Are Informed of Any Security Anomalies

Security Anomaly Type	Where to Check	Recommended Frequency to Check
All access, user, and conference activities	Log files record user activities and all login attempts (successful and unsuccessful).	Daily

Note: Security anomalies are available only to the Poly support team.

How Customer Personal Data Is Deleted

Data Type	Steps to Delete	Deletion Method
Users	<p>Users are deleted by performing a comprehensive application removal.</p> <p>To remove the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite application and delete the localusers.js file:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Log into the Windows server hosting the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite. 2. Select Start > Settings > Add/Remove applications. 3. Select the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite and select Remove. 4. In the dialog box, select Remove to confirm the removal and select OK. This restarts the server. 5. When the application is removed and server rebooted, log in again to the same server. 6. Go to <i>C:\ProgramData\Polycom\WorkflowServer\config</i>. 7. Delete the <i>localusers.js</i> file. 8. Go to the recycle bin on the desktop and right click the empty recycle bin icon. <p>To delete users:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 Log in to the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite with administrator privileges <a href="https://<workflowIPAddress>/admin">https://<workflowIPAddress>/admin 2 Select Users > Local users. 3 Select the red bin icon next to the user you wish to remove. 4 Select Yes you wish to confirm the deletion of the user. 5 Select Log out in the top-right corner. 	<p>Simple delete from file system.</p>

System log files	The system deletes log files automatically (oldest first) when the file size reaches 200 MB. The number of archivable log files is configurable by the administrator.	Files delete with overwrite.
	To delete log files:	
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1 Login with administrator rights to the Windows server hosting the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite.2 Go to <i>C:\ProgramData\Polycom\WorkflowServer\logs</i>.3 Delete all the <i>App.log</i> files.4 Go to the recycle bin and right-click the empty recycle bin.	
	To reduce the number of log files stored:	
	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1 Log in to the Workflow Suite or Clariti Workflow Lite with administrator privileges <a href="https://<workflowIPAddress>/admin">https://<workflowIPAddress>/admin2 Select Admin > System.3 Under Logs heading, change the setting Maximum number of log files to the desired number (default is 5).4 Select Save.
