## What's New

## *Call Recording Enhancements*

You can enable the call recording feature on a per SP service basis. The following softkeys and user options are now available during an active call:

- RcStart (start a recording)
- RcPaus (pause a recording)
- RcStp (stop a recording)
- ReRsm (resume a recording)

The **Enable Call Recording Controls** configuration option is disabled by default. See the [Poly Edge B Series IP Phones Administrator Guide](#) for information on configuring this feature in the system web interface.

## ***Hold Key Update***

The hold key now also allows you to return to a call that is on hold. Simply press the hold key to switch between the hold a call and resume a call functions.

## ***Default Input Mode***

Alphanumeric mode is now the default input mode when you search for contacts in the phone book. This means that letters display in the search field as you enter your search criteria. You can press the Mode softkey to cycle through the available input modes and switch to a different mode.

## ***New Root CA Certificates***

This release adds the following Root CA certificates:

- IdenTrust Commercial Root CA 1
- ISRG Root X1

| Conference Management | <a href="#">EN-212809</a> | When multiple Softkey pages are present and the phone updates the Softkey list after a user performs an action on Softkey page 2, the phone UI does not refresh the screen to show that the Softkey list is now on page 1. The user may then select an incorrect Softkey option after this update.<br>For example, if the user selects the "Record Start" softkey on page #2 for the current call, the phone adds the "Record Pause" and "Record Stop" Softkey options. After this update, the phone UI shows the Softkey page 2 instead of the current page 1 list. |
| User Interface        | <a href="#">EN-212561</a> | When multiple Softkey pages are present and the phone updates the Softkey list after a user performs an action on Softkey page 2, the phone UI does not refresh the screen to show that the Softkey list is now on page 1.
